Resolution of the James River Valley Library System Board Concerning Challenged Materials

- 1. Any patron objecting to materials will be asked to fill out a "Citizen's Request for Reconsideration of a Work."
- 2. A special meeting of the library board, the director, and the patron making the complaint will be called to review and evaluate the material. Evidence, in the form of critical reviews, will be introduced if available.
- 3. A unanimous vote by the seven members of the library board may remove the material.
- 4. If no such decision can be reached, the patron will then have to bring suit in order to have the challenged material removed.
